Purpose: The Catholic Community Foundation is proud to provide the Frank & Florence Coseglia Scholarship to one college bound financially needy student graduating from each of the Catholic High schools in the Diocese of Venice, Florida.

Award: A one-year, non-renewable scholarship of approximately \$1,100 will be awarded this year for tuition, books, fees and tutoring services (housing and living expenses not eligible). *Members or relatives of the Catholic Community Foundation staff, Board of Directors, the Office of Catholic Schools, the Scholarship Committee are ineligible to apply.*

Eligibility:

- Current high school senior at one of the Diocese of Venice Catholic high schools. Bishop Verot, Cardinal Mooney, Rhodora Donahue, St. John Neumann
- Financial needs assessment, will submit SAI score from FAFSA
- Submission of an essay on what your Catholic education has meant to you along with your future goals and how they will be achieved.
- Acceptance into an accredited college or university
- Significant service to school and Parish
- Academic performance
