Now Accepting Applications for the 2026-27 Academic Year

Purpose: The Catholic Community Foundation is proud to provide the Frank & Florence Coseglia Scholarship to one college-bound financially needy student graduating from each of the Catholic High schools in the Diocese of Venice in Florida.

Award: A one-year, non-renewable scholarship of approximately \$1,100 will be awarded this year for tuition, books, fees and tutoring services (housing and living expenses not eligible). Members or relatives of the Catholic Community Foundation staff, Board of Directors, the Office of Catholic Schools, and the Scholarship Committee are ineligible to apply.



Eligibility

- Current high school senior at one of the Diocese of Venice Catholic high schools. (Bishop Verot, Cardinal Mooney, Rhodora Donahue, St. John Neumann);
- Financial needs assessment, will submit the SAI score from the 2026-27 FAFSA;
- Submission of an essay on what your Catholic education has meant to you, along with your future goals and how they will be achieved;
- Acceptance into an accredited college or university;
- Significant service to the school and Parish;
- Academic performance
